GRATEFUL TO GOD

As I begin my fifth year as Director of Missions, I have spent much time in prayer and in the Word of God. I have recently read a scripture-based biography of the ministry of Jesus and the apostle Paul.

Like Nehemiah, God has laid a vision and a burden on my heart for our Association as we diligently work to fulfill the Great Commission. The burden on my heart is to see scores of people reached for Christ in a fast-growing Baldwin County. This involves churches, ministries and intentional strategies to share the gospel.

We live in a world where the number of people coming to Christ for salvation and baptism is declining. In spite of this, we have seen God do great things here in our Association over the past 10 years.

The reported baptisms from our churches have been steady. Since 2007, there have been about 500 reported baptisms each year, with a total of 5,454 people reported as being baptized over the last 10 years. Yet, we do not continue to see a great rise in baptisms. Wouldn't it be great to see at least a thousand people come to Christ in a year!

It is important that we start new work but there must also be a major emphasis for our existing churches who have land, buildings, ministries and resources to focus outward, reaching people, baptizing and discipling them.

This all begins with prayer. At our next Ministers' Conference, we will focus on a prayer emphasis that will, hopefully, take us down every street and road in Baldwin County. Our desire is that this will change our focus from within to a focus on the lost and unchurched without.

I'm asking that all of our ministers be present at our next Ministers' Conference in August as we look at an emphasis to reach our county for Christ. We need your input and support as we begin this great prayer effort.
