We need YOUR CHURCH to help us! Check out these opportunities for your church to minister to the fair employees and fair-goers.

- 1) **HOME COOKED LUNCHES:** providing a hot lunch for approx. 50 fair workers, serving from 11:30 am-1:00pm. Need 4-6 people each day, Monday-Friday.
- 2) **CONVERSATION:** sitting with the fair workers during lunch, to hear their stories and, hopefully, open the door to evangelism and prayers. (Same times/days as above.)
- 3) **LAUNDRY WORKERS:** working in the laundry unit to wash, dry and fold fair workers' laundry. Shifts between 8 am to ?, 4-6 people, Tuesday thru Friday.
- 4) **SHUTTLE VANS AND DRIVERS:** driving workers to Walmart, drug store, etc. as needs arise. 8 am to 2 pm daily, Mon. thru Friday, 2 to 4 people per day.
- 5) **PRAY-ERS:** come to the fair early, engage workers in conversation and ask for prayer requests; pray! Anytime between 8 am-2 pm, 2-4 people, Monday thru Friday.
- 6) **CRAFT TIME DURING THE FAIR:** working with Gulf Area Resort Ministries to provide craft activities for children who attend the fair; 3:30pm-9:30pm nightly (Saturday 10 am-9:30 pm); 10-12 people on Tuesday-Saturday.
