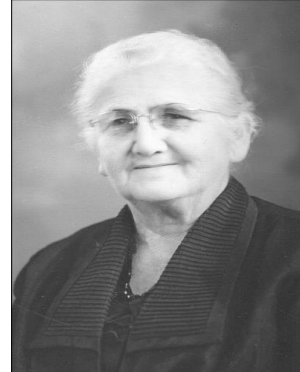


# ANNIE RHODES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

## Annie Elana Rhodes (1892-1973)

Ms. Rhodes was born August 9, 1892 in Fort Deposit, Alabama. Her life was one of commitment to the Women's Missionary Union because of her love for missions. This love brought about a desire in her to see other women learn to pray and give to missions. She endeavored to encourage others to action by serving as W.M.U. District Vice-President. She also served in the Baldwin Association as W.M.U. President, Vice-President, "Community Missions" Chairman, and Prayer Chairman. Following her death in 1973, the Annie Rhodes Memorial Scholarship was established in 1975 in honor of her Christ-like love and service to others.
