## BECAUSE THEY HAVE NEVER HEARD SHARING JESUS IN COVID TIMES

The Covid Pandemic has affected us and our churches in many ways. We have had to adapt in many ways. Through the media and in our own observation, Covid has caught our attention and influenced our thinking.

The one area we must not take our focus off is sharing the gospel and the work of the Great Commission. - 3. As churches of Christ believers, we must not let Covid take our focus off of sharing Christ. We must not have the mindset of focusing on sharing the gospel after Covid. Now is the time, and not later, to pray for the lost and share the message of hope and peace that comes from knowing the living Savior.

The Baldwin Baptist Association must also have a laser like focus on sharing the gospel in everything that we do. These are golden days of opportunities. People need the Lord.
